What is Behavioral Interviewing for Student Employees?

Because Laboratory Managers are beginning to use behavior based interviewing techniques, we are offering this opportunity for student employees. The behavior-based interviewing process helps employees learn how to profile their skills based on career experience and enhances successful matching of potential employees with job requirements. Participants will learn how to assess and communicate their skills in a positive, organized manner and how to develop skill-based career goals. To participate in this class you must register online at the Virtual Training Center from the Laboratory's home page by choosing Training/Learning in the lower left-hand corner. 
Safety/Security Tip of the Week
